******TIME SENSITIVE:** American Lutheran Church Scholarship Program -_Applications for the American Lutheran Church Scholarship Program are now being accepted. The application process has two phases: 1) An intent to apply must be submitted by January 31 of each year. The intent to apply is to fill out the scholarship application and submit it to the Scholarship committee. 2) The final scholarship application form with a transcript must be submitted by June 15. Application forms are available in the church office with a list of the regulations on the backside.



You may also access the application online by going to the church website, clicking on news and information, and then clicking on youth scholarship. To apply for this scholarship, a student must be a member in good standing at American Lutheran Church and must be at the sophomore or higher level at any undergraduate or graduate college or university. You may only receive a scholarship for three years. A student cannot simultaneously receive a scholarship from both the ALC Scholarship Program and the Etta Janssen Scholarship Program.

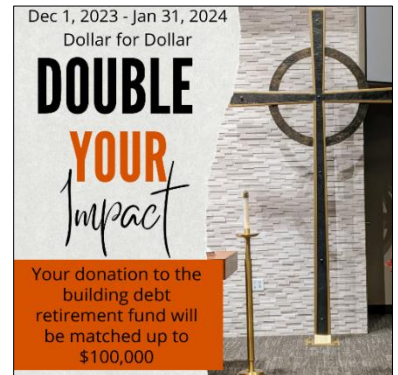

BUILDING DEBT REDUCTION MINISTRIES

Matching Gift: A group of visionaries from ALC have combined their financial assets to provide the seed money for this unique matching gift project to reduce our debt. Your gift, small and large, will be matched dollar for dollar up \$100,000. This matching gift program runs from Dec 1, 2023, through January 31, 2024. Write “Building Match” on the memo line. If you have questions, please contact one of the pastors, Sandy, or Marv. *As of January 21, approximately \$80,000 has been given and will be matched. This means approximately \$160,000 will be designated to reduce the balance of the building debt.*



Grocery Cards: Thanks to your participation in the Grocery Gift Card program, our *Building Debt has been reduced by almost \$7,000 since November 1, 2021. Your generosity is a gift to the entire congregation.* Please consider contributing to that debt reduction! Purchase your Hy-Vee and Fareway Gift Cards on the 1st and 3rd Sundays, before services, or on weekdays in the church office. You receive full-value cards with 5% of each purchase going to our building debt reduction ministry.
