Ways to Financially Support God's Work Through Our Hands

Read about ways you can financially support ministry at ALC. Find a pathway that fits you.

Pathway to Support: Gift Cards

- Grocery Cards: Please consider contributing to that debt reduction! Purchase your Hy-Vee and Fareway Gift Cards on the 1st and 3rd Sundays, before services, or on weekdays in the church office. Checks are preferred, made out to American Lutheran Building Fund, with "Gift Cards" on the memo line. Contact Harlan or Pam Handevidt at 507-376-5682.
- Various Gift Cards: Make an intentional stop in downtown Worthington to Main Steet Kids and ask to purchase available gift cards for American Lutheran Church. A percentage of your purchase supports the middle school and high school youth program.

Pathway to Sacrificial Giving: Building Debt Retirement: As a congregation, we are focused on a specific ministry of reducing our building debt. If you are able to give sacrificially to this ministry, contact Sandy Demuth in the Church Office.

Pathway to Support: Sustaining Offerings: God's mission relies on all types of givers. What kind of giver are you? Below is a description of types of Americans Givers (donors) to non-profit organizations. *Consider which description best fits your giving*. As a congregation, ALC's ability to serve God and speak about Jesus' love is dependent on each of these types of givers. Connect with Marv Isder, Sandy Demuth, or even one of ALC's pastors as you discover the intersection of financial stewardship and your faith. (This article comes from the Lake Institute of Faith & Giving. This section is reprinted with permission).

- **Planned Givers:** Follow systems or routines of giving and make conscious decisions to give more money away. About 16% of donors are Planned Givers.
- **Habitual Givers**: Follow systems or routines of giving, yet also just happen to give. About 6% of donors are Habitual Givers.
- Selective Givers: Make a conscious decision to give, yet also give spontaneously. About 17% of donors are Selective Givers.
- **Impulsive Givers:** Are spontaneous or situational in their giving, which just happens. About 42% of donors are Impulsive Givers.
- **Atypical Givers:** Identified as a non-giver for one question but selected a giver approach for the second. About 19% of donors are Atypical Givers.
